

MINUTES OF GREAT WHITTINGTON AGM DATED 10th JUNE 2025 AT 7.00pm

2. Minutes of the Previous Meeting. These were agreed as correct and signed
3. Matters Arising. There were no matters arising
4. Committee Report. The report from the chair including the financial statement was presented. The accounts had been independently assessed by Henry Brown and were passed unanimously.
5. The Border Outside the Garden Wall. This was the subject of quite a long discussion and the following points were raised.
