CHARITY COMMISSION.

In the matter of the Charity known as Barrasford Village Hall,
at Barrasford, in the County of Northumberland, regulated
by a conveyance and trust deed dated the 7th September
1973; and
In the matter of the Charities Act, 1960.

THE CHARITY COMMISSIONERS FOR ENGLAND AND WALES HEREBY ORDER
that the land specified in the schedule hereto shall vest forthwith in
the Official Custodian for Charities for all the estate and interest
therein belonging to or held in trust for the Charity.

containing 0.062 hectares or thereabouts with the buildings thereon known
as Barrasford Village Hall being the property comprised in the above-

part, the Right Honorable Charles Ingham Courtenay and two others of the
second part and Thomas Milburn and another of the third part.
