Performances will take place on

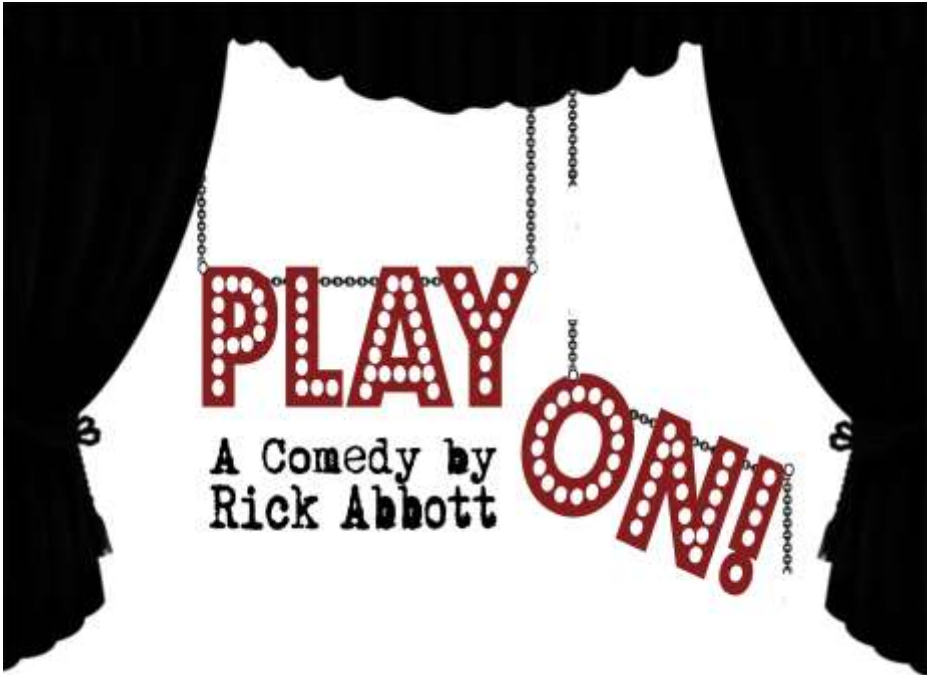

# October Board Meeting

2025 membership and hire charges, and the need to cover heating costs, were discussed at length. It has been decided that 'Sections' will be abolished as being no longer relevant to the structure of Stocksfield Community Association (SCA), which has been a Charitable Incorporated Organisation since 2018. Historically, from around 1960, Sections were groups of members taking part in a particular activity at the community centre. Representatives of the Sections formed the management committee. By the time SICA gained charitable status in 2011 – and dropped the 'Institute' at the insistence of Companies House – new groups had been formed and more people from outside the village were coming to the centre. Nowadays, most of our users do not belong to a Section, and SCA is run by a board of trustees, themselves members of the association, who are elected by the members at the AGM.

It was minuted that the local business owner with whom we had discussed renting rooms on the top floor of the building has decided not to proceed, due to the large room not being offered for exclusive hire.

Energy and property matters were again discussed. It is likely that Northern Powergrid will be upgrading our electricity to a 3 phase supply in December. Once this is done, and our energy supplier and our electrician have connected the supply to our meter and the internal wiring, we will be able to go ahead with improvements to the heating system in the hall. We are hoping to make a decision at the November board meeting, but this may depend on the outcome of a grant application.

The manager reported that tickets for the Stocksfield Player's production of 'Play On', to be performed on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> and Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> November, are selling well. On Friday 13<sup>th</sup> December there will be a performance by the Custom House Big Band in the hall. Both of these events were very popular last year, and tickets for either can be obtained from the office.

## **Extraordinary General Meeting of Stocksfield Community Association**

This took place on 15<sup>th</sup> October at 7pm in the Community Centre. The annual accounts were presented by the acting treasurer of the association. The members approved the accounts. These will be sent to the Charity Commission along with the Annual Report.
