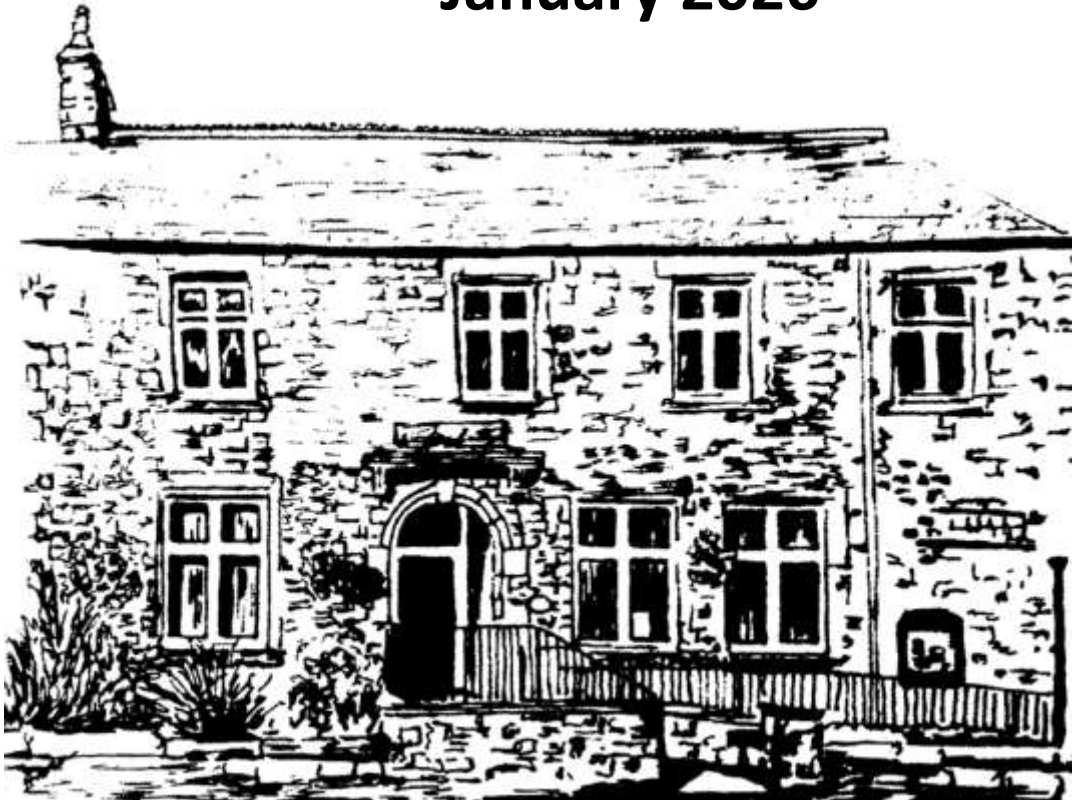

## November Board Meeting

Following recommendations in the Hallmark 2 Report, the Board approved the new Social Media Policy and changes to the Room Hire Policy. The updated Guest Acceptable Use Wi-Fi Policy was agreed in October, and there are new notices in the Community Centre regarding the use of Wi-Fi.

The trustees discussed placing a free standing name board in front of the building, as neighbours tell us that guests and new users are not always able to find it. Another option would be to place a sign on the wall facing the main road. We intend to look at this in more detail before our next meeting.

The Treasurer reported that both income and expenditure increased in October. The increase in income was mainly due to hire payments, as more people are now using the Community Centre. Early sales of the SICA Christmas Quiz and other fundraising activities also contributed income. The increase in expenditure was due to payment for the work to upgrade the storage batteries and associated infrastructure. This is reducing energy costs in the long run.

The Property Report dealt with a number of issues, from moving two of the thermostats for the infrared heaters, to clearing leaves from gutters and downpipes in Autumn. Following the upgrade to the storage batteries mentioned above, we are hoping to sell a master battery, 2 AC inverters and control box, which are now surplus to requirements.
