Village Hall Wi-Fi and Broadband Acceptable Use Policy

1. Purpose

This policy outlines the acceptable use of the Village Hall's Wi-Fi and broadband services. By accessing the network, users agree to comply with the terms outlined in this policy.

2. Access and Availability

- Users will be provided with the Wi-Fi network name and password.
- The Wi-Fi service is available during hall operating hours and is subject to availability.
- Technical support for connecting to the Wi-Fi network is not provided.

3. Acceptable Use

Users must:

- Use the Wi-Fi service for lawful purposes only.
- Respect the privacy and intellectual property rights of others.
- Avoid activities that may disrupt or interfere with the network or other users.
- Ensure their devices are secure and free from malware or viruses before connecting.

Prohibited activities include, but are not limited to:

- Accessing or distributing offensive, obscene, or illegal content.
- Engaging in hacking, phishing, or other malicious activities.
- Downloading or sharing copyrighted material without permission.

4. Security and Privacy

- The Wi-Fi network is unsecured. Users should avoid transmitting sensitive personal information over the network.
- Users are responsible for securing their own devices. The hall is not liable for any loss or damage resulting from the use of the Wi-Fi service.
- The hall reserves the right to monitor network usage to ensure compliance with this policy.

5. Liability

The hall makes no representations or warranties regarding the availability, reliability, or security of the Wi-Fi service.

6. Enforcement

Failure to adhere to this policy may result in the suspension or termination of Wi-Fi access and potential reporting to relevant authorities.
