November Board Meeting

Since the Board last met in early October, the majority of the work to improve and update the heating system for most of the ground floor rooms has been completed. A ventilated lockable cupboard has been built around the storage batteries and AC chargers, and the last of the electric radiators has been installed. As well as controlling the batteries and chargers manually we can control the system via an app, which two trustees have downloaded. We are now waiting for our energy supplier to install isolators to both phases of our electricity supply so that the load can be balanced between them. Unfortunately it is not, for various reasons, practical to improve the heating system for the hall at present, and it remains an expensive space to heat.

One of the trustees has put together the ever-popular Christmas Quiz - hours of fun and frustration for only £2. This is available from the office, some of the local businesses, and from trustees. Tickets are selling well for the Stocksfield Players performance of 'A Christmas Carol' on the 8th and 9th of December. Those of us who attended the Custom House Big Band Concert in November had a very enjoyable evening, and we are hoping to book them again in 2024.

The Board meets again on the 12th December. Since this is a double issue of SCAN, the December board meeting report will appear in the February issue along with the January report.

Sadly I have to report the death, after a short illness, of long time member Jean Fisher -who for a number of years was a trustee of Stocksfield Institute Community Association – before it changed its name and charitable status in 2011.

Jean's involvement with the Community Centre began back in 1967 when Stocksfield Playgroup opened and Jean became its first leader. During the Northumberland Village Halls Heritage Project I interviewed Jean to record her memories of the early days of Stocksfield Playgroup, which remained open until 2015. Copies of this recording are now held by Northumberland Archives.

After moving to live with family in Prudhoe Jean joined Stocksfield Tuesday Club and much enjoyed meeting old friends every week for lunch. She made an important contribution to a video produced by Community Action Northumberland filmed at several 'Warm Hubs' across the county. Jean will be much missed by her many friends in both Stocksfield & Prudhoe – especially those who enjoyed her company at 'Tuesday Club'.
