## **May Board Meeting**

The problem of heating the hall in an energy efficient manner was again discussed. A group of three trustees are investigating solutions, which might include infra-red heaters or an air source heat pump. Advances in technology mean that these are potentially viable; however we are seeking more information and expert advice. It has become apparent that we will need a three-phase electricity supply to support any new system. A quote has been received from Northern Powergrid, and work will also be needed to modernize the infrastructure. We hope to receive grant funding to cover most of this.

Unfortunately our recently co-opted treasurer is unable to continue, and has left the Board. One of the trustees has taken on the role for the present.

The annual review of policies took place in May, and the Board approved the SCA policies for the next 12 months.

The Climate Edition of SCAN was produced and printed just before the board meeting, and several trustees and members of our trading arm SCATA have been busy delivering copies and questionnaires around Stocksfield. We are hoping to get an idea of level of interest from residents in reducing carbon emissions and improving energy efficiency in homes in the village.

The meeting ended with a presentation to Ineke Gijsbers, who has been a trustee of Stocksfield Community Association for 12 years and was treasurer of SCATA, and will soon be moving away from the village. The chairwoman thanked Ineke for her service to our community.

## FRIENDS OF STOCKSFIELD COMMUNITY WOODLAND – A RECAP.

Firstly, a reminder as to who we are.

Stocksfield Community Woodland is the

area of woods and open grassy spaces immediately to the west of Guessburn, on either side of the B6309; there is a small car park on the right as you turn off the main road to go to Hindley. Although owned and managed by Allendale Estates, maintenance of the footpaths stopped several years ago. FoSCW was setup in 2022 and has been cutting the paths since then, funded by grants and public donations.

Next, and most importantly, a big thank you to everyone who has donated to our fundraising effort; so far we have raised over £600 to add to our grants from the Parish Council and other bodies. It was lovely to speak to people at Stocksfield Festival last summer and to hear so many words of encouragement and support.

We are now into our 3rd year: the paths are now much more manageable, a section of footpath behind Guessburn has been levelled and resurfaced and 2 sets of steps have been created where a path is particularly steep and awkward to navigate. After such a wet winter these improvements have been greatly appreciated, and further projects are planned. The thistles and nettles are now growing back at an alarming speed, and it will soon be time for the first cut of the year, keeping a special lookout for orchids! For all this work to continue, fundraising is inevitably an ongoing activity and we really appreciate your help with this. Knowing that people care is just as important as the financial side.
